RE: Directions hearing for Royal Commission into the abuse of children in Detention in the Northern Territory

Thank you for meeting with APONT to discuss the Royal Commission. As we explained, APONT and its members believe this Commission is a critical opportunity for a proper examination of issues of juvenile detention, and will involve very significant issues for policy and law reform in this area.
